- 13.1 Discussion of Pittsburg Tank & Tower Quote Water Tower Maintenance (attachment). Deferred to when Chris is present to answer questions on the quote to determine required services.
- 13.2 Police new cell phones and laptop computers (attachment). Chief Buehler informed of several issues. The current I-phone system (I-win \$221/month) is being discontinued soon. There have been recent problems with coverage through this AT&T system. The new system (SOIL Government \$305/month)) is a Verizon based system and offers better coverage within the town. This system is compatible with both the phones and laptops. It will be placed on the next agenda for a vote.

- 13.3 Increase in Part-time Police Pay for Special Event. Currently the Special Event pay for patrol officers is \$25.25/hr. Part-time pay is \$26.51/hr. Traditionally SE pay has been \$3/hr more than PT pay which would then be \$29.51/hr. Item to be placed on the next agenda for a vote.
